Discovery Questions (hear *and* put into practice—Matthew 7:24)

- In this week’s sermon Pastor David said you are the One degree in the life of someone who doesn’t know the Lord. What does that mean to you? Stop and pray for your One person with expectation that God will do something BIG in that person’s life.
- Praying for One is risky. God wants everyone to come to Him through Jesus (2 Peter 3:9) Discuss what you risk when sharing your faith with an unbeliever? Discuss what is risked if you don’t.
- When you are taking ground for Jesus, the enemy will come against you. This is called spiritual warfare. Some describe it as feeling like they have a bullseye on their back. They feel like they are doing something wrong, but really they are doing something very right. We are in a spiritual battle for the people we know and love. Praise God we are given tools to fight against the enemy. Read about the Armor of God and talk about what each piece means. Ephesians 6:10-20
- Jesus gave us a new command which is to love one another **as He loved us**. (John 13:34) Jesus’s love for us took Him to a Cross. He risked it all. John 15:13 “Greater love has no one than this that he lay down his life for his friends.” On a scale of 1-10, how are you doing at loving people like this, as Jesus loved you?
- Do you believe you can be the tool God uses to bring someone to the Lord? Is there anything more important? Read John 3:16-18 out loud.
- If you are a believer in Christ Jesus, you were the One at some point in your life that someone was praying for. Who was praying for you? Who brought you to the Lord? Have you ever thanked them? Discuss this and then thank that person this week, if you can.
