



**Life in His Name, Part 5**  
**“The Lamb of God”**  
**May 15-16, 2021**

Discuss with your life group or gather your friends or family to increase the impact of this weekend's message.

**Life Application Questions** (what is God doing in your life?)

- How are you seeing God at work in you and around you? (Good focus for prayers of praise and thanksgiving)
- What is a challenge you're facing? How can our group help? (Guides your group members into caring community and prayer)
- What Bible verse or passage has the Lord been using to speak to you this past week? (Points group members to regular devotional time)
- How might the Lord be using your circumstances and relationships to grow your faith? (Invites the Lord to use our entire lives for His purposes)

**Discovery Questions** (hear *and* put into practice)

- Read [John 1:29-34](#).
- Jews in Jesus day were expecting a Messiah who would deliver them from Roman oppression, yet John the Baptizer refers to Jesus as “the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world.” What was John saying about the mission of Jesus? (Old Testament references include Ex. 12:1-13; 29:38-41; Is. 53:4-9).
- John also used the term “Lamb” 7x in the book of Revelation to refer to the resurrected and reigning Jesus. Why do you think he did this, and why is it important to us?
- Whenever we share communion we are not only remembering the gift of salvation, but receiving wholeheartedly the giver of salvation. Why is it important to receive all that Jesus is and all that He does before going out to serve Him?
- Read [1 Peter 1:18-19](#). When you think of the price that was paid for us to be made right with God, how does that your motivation toward holiness or Christ likeness?
- John said Jesus would baptize not with water, but with the Holy Spirit. Every true Christian has the Holy Spirit (Ro. 8:9); how do you rely on His guidance and power, especially to produce godly character in you?
- Close in a time of prayer, responding to whatever the Lord is saying to you.
