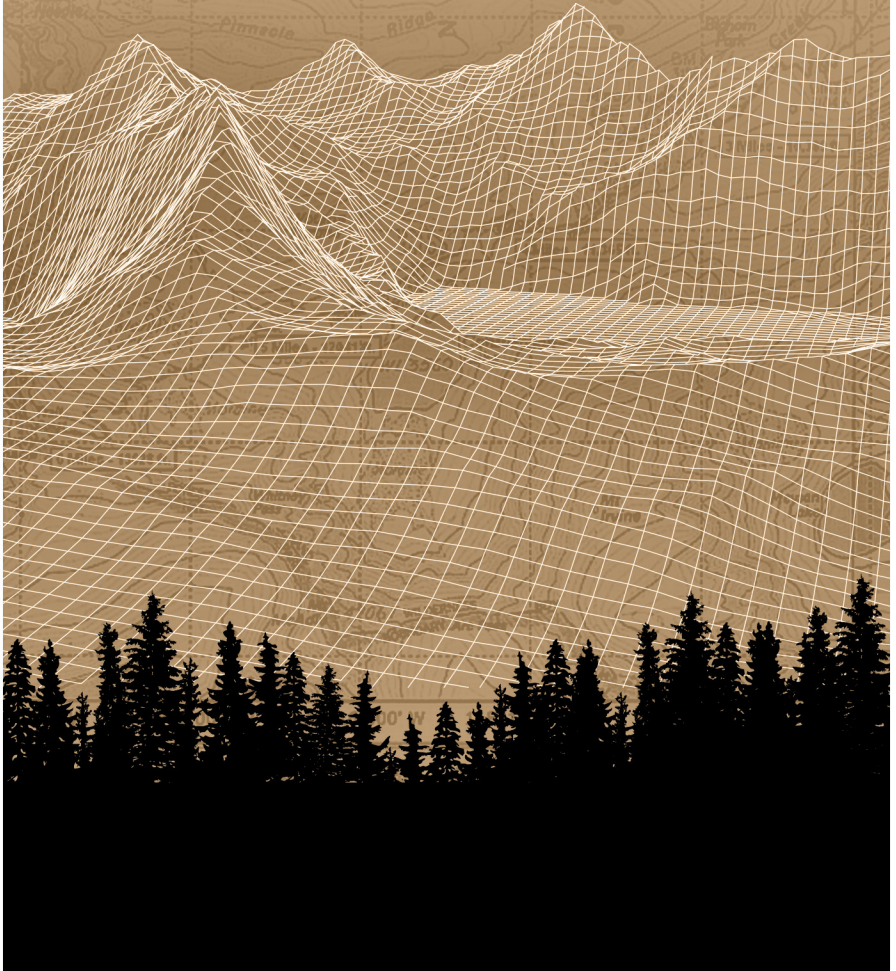
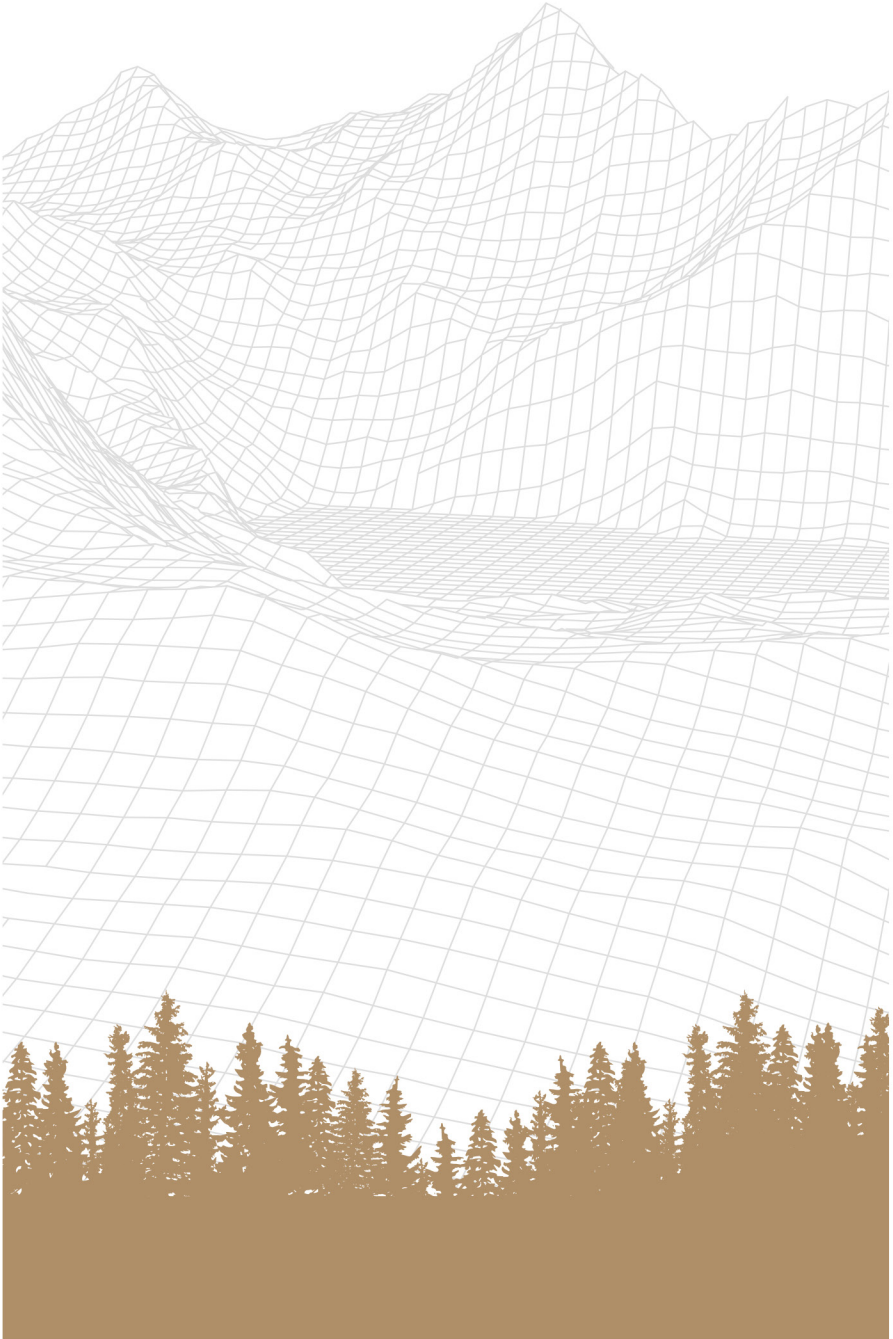

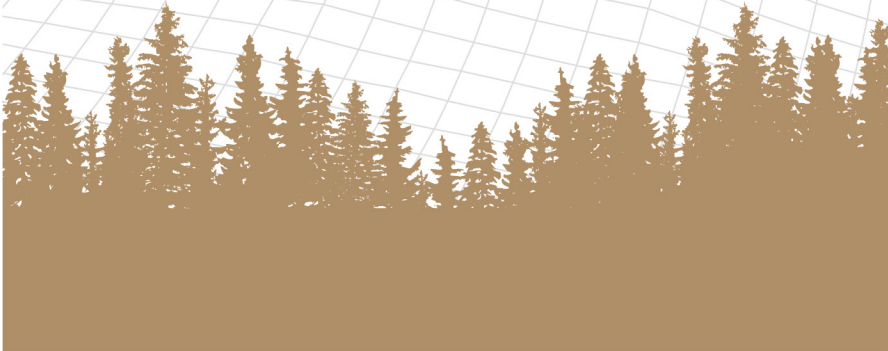

5. Do you think the promise of redemption and forgiveness eliminates the earthly repercussions we suffer if we are disobedient? Why or why not?



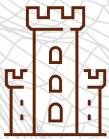

8. Read Job 1:6-12. How hard is it for you to believe that God is good when you see him destroy the people in the flood, or allow Job to suffer?

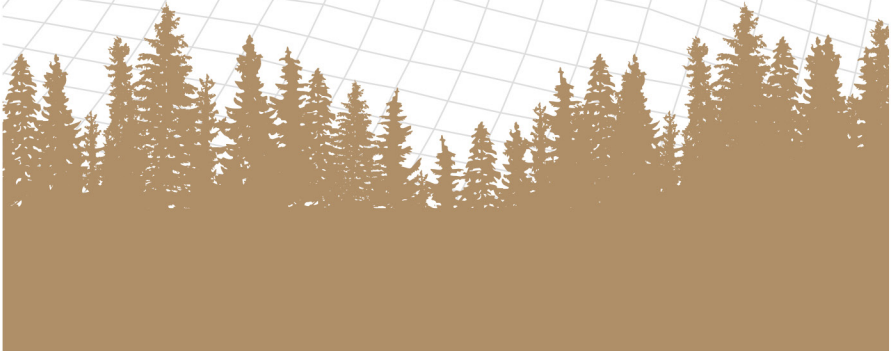
