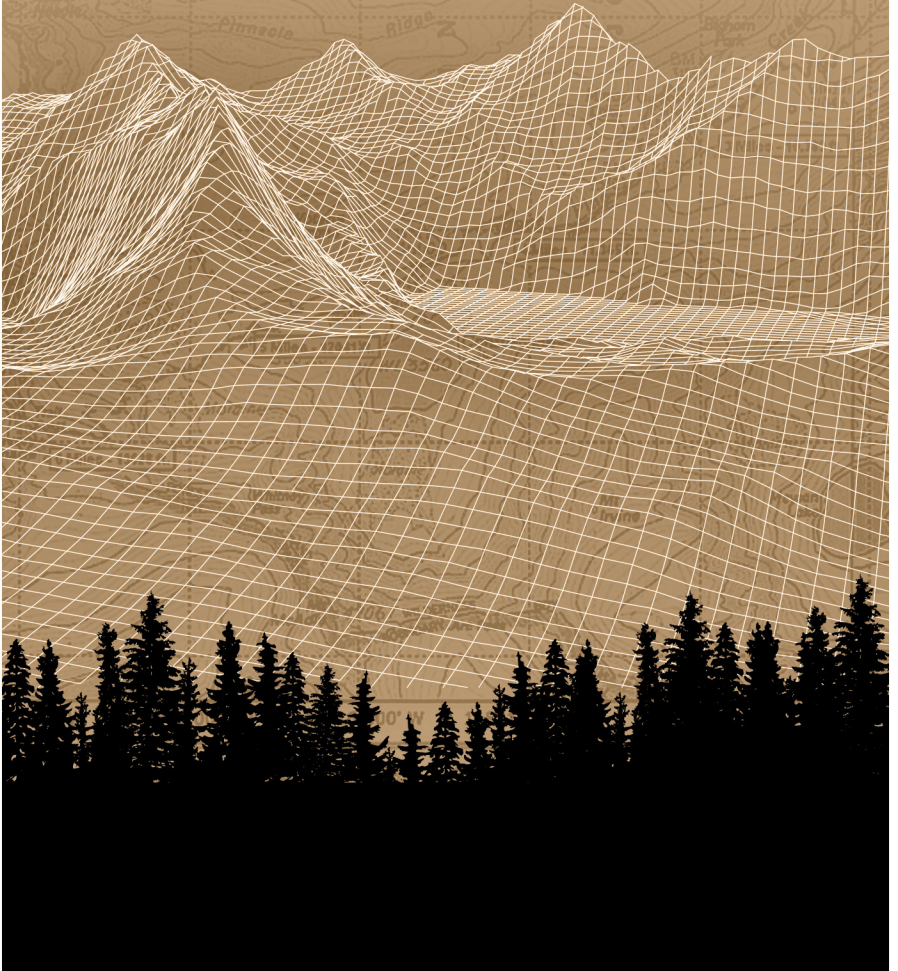
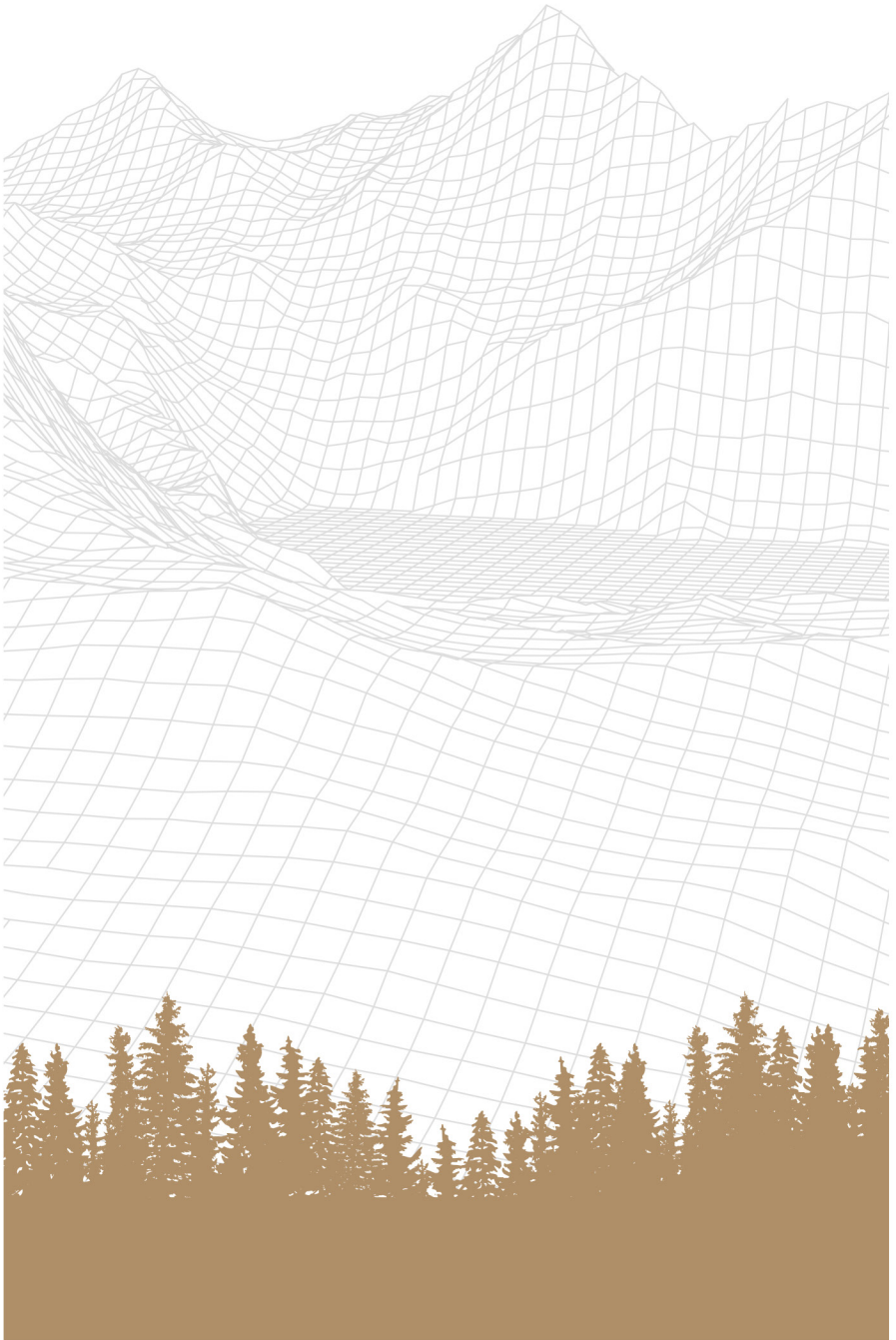

## THE SUMMIT

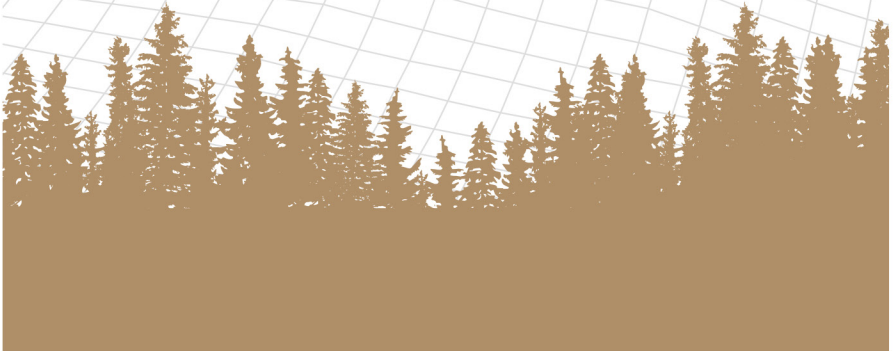
1. What part of the Epic Adventure was new to you?
